FLOODLIGHTS ON CLUB EVENINGS 7.00pm to 9.30pm

If floodlights are required on Club Nights the lights should be switched on free of charge.

In the event of no key holder being present with a key to switch the lights on/off, members who have purchased tokens in advance are recommended to use these.

Tokens used will be returned to members at a later date. Tokens and a key for the outer light box, if required, are available with advance notice from Peter Messenger - contact details - e mailpeterkm@live.co.uk

A token costs £1 and gives ½ hour of lighting per court. Please note that when the lights go out there is a 15-minute delay before the lights can be switched on again.

Remember – keep the meter fed for continuous lighting or move to another court.

To reclaim tokens used on club nights just add the relevant details to the Token Reclaim list on the club house notice board and e mail Peter Messenger.

Members who attend club evening sessions regularly and have been in the position of not being able to play at 7.00pm due to lack of light would be advised to purchase tokens in advance. We recommend a maximum of 5 tokens for such occasions.

In addition to replacing tokens for members who purchase for club sessions the club will buy back any unwanted tokens at the end of each winter season

All members who have full access to switch the floodlights on have the letters FLK in their e mail address title used by the tennis club. These members are only authorised to switch the floodlights on for club nights, league matches and official tournaments, excluding proceeding rounds in the annual club tournament.
